

Fall 2022 American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For college students pursuing a degree and career related to the planning, design, or construction of highways. It is ASHE's intent to award at least 1 scholarship(s) to at least 1 eligible candidate(s).

Eligibility and Instructions

Eligibility:

- 1. Enrolled in a college or university located within 125 miles of Austin, Texas.
- 2. Enrolled in an accredited Associates, Bachelor's or Master's degree program related to transportation planning, transportation engineering or transportation construction.
- 3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in your junior or senior year, or graduate student, for the Spring 2023 semester.
- 4. Must not be on academic probation.
- 5. Must not have already received an ASHE scholarship in a prior year.
- 6. Must be able to accept the award in person, virtually or via representative at the December 13, 2022 ASHE Central Texas Section Meeting.

Instructions:

- 1. Download the PDF application from the ASHE Central Texas Section website located at: https://ctx.ashe.pro/scholarship-program. Complete the application. The application must be typed and your responses cannot exceed the space provided.
- 3. Attach an enclosed copy of your current (Spring 2022) official transcripts.
- 4. Consent to the following:

If awarded an ASHE Central Texas Scholarship Award:

I understand that if offered an award I must enroll, or be enrolled, in a highway industry-related curriculum as a full-time undergraduate student at an accredited university for the Spring 2022 semester in order to receive the award. I understand that if offered an award I must accept the award in person, virtually or by a representative at the December 13, 2022 ASHE Central Texas Section Meeting (info at ctx.ashe.pro). By signing, I grant permission to have information about this award shared with members of ASHE as well as the public.
