






US 290 at SH 71 During Construction (September 2024)






Planned US 290 at SH 71




Roll Plots

multiple sheets


New technology (iPads)

Drone usage


- Obtain aerial footage instead of KMZs
- Gather quantities faster than traditional surveying
- Engage stakeholders in dynamic ways





Narrowed Acceptance Limits

- Unit price project = bonus/deduct ranges
- Lump sum project = had to fix the value for the bid = no bonus/deduct
- Narrowed acceptance limits = removes the bonus/deduct range but makes target values smaller
- Smaller acceptance targets = increased NCRs = bad optics for Management
