SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For college students pursuing a degree and career related to the planning, design, or construction of highways. It is ASHE CTX's intent to award scholarship(s) to eligible candidate(s) worth an estimated total amount of at least \$10,000.

Eligibility and Instructions

Eligibility:

1. Enrolled in a college or university located in the state of Texas within the Greater Austin region. Eligible universities include: **The University of Texas at Austin, Texas State University, Texas A&M University, Concordia University Texas, Huston-Tillotson Texas, and Southwestern University.** For inquiries about the eligibility of other Greater Austin-area colleges or universities, please email the scholarship committee.
2. Enrolled in an accredited bachelor's or master's degree program related to transportation planning, transportation engineering, or transportation construction.
3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in your junior or senior year, or graduate student, for the Fall 2026 semester.
4. Must not be on academic probation.
5. Must not have already received an ASHE scholarship.
6. Must be able to accept the award in person, virtually, or via a representative at the November 10, 2026, ASHE Central Texas Section Meeting.

Instructions:

1. Download the PDF application from the ASHE Central Texas Section website located at: <https://ctx.ashe.pro/scholarship-program>. Your responses must be typed and cannot exceed the space provided.
2. Attach an enclosed copy of your current transcripts.
3. Consent to the following:

If awarded an ASHE Central Texas Scholarship Award:

By signing, I grant permission for information about this award to be shared with ASHE members and the public.
